

Professional Trustee Training Course

Summary

This is a two-day course offered by and endorsed by the APRSF - Asociace pro podporu a rozvoj svěřenských fondů, z. s. and presented by experienced presenters from Svěřenské fondy a trusty s.r.o., Deloitte, and J&T Family Office a.s..

The successful completion of the course, including the final examination, will result in the issue of a certificate of attendance and completion.

The course will provide an in-depth understanding of the structure, history and practical applications of Trusts in the Czech Republic as well as detailed coverage of the duties and obligations of Trustees. It is not intended to equip participants with enough information to independently establish a trust – In this regard participants should always work with an experienced APRSF member.

Who is this course for?

This course is designed for:

- Professional persons who are considering or have accepted appointment as trustee of a Czech trust
- Lawyers, financial advisers, notaries and others who would like a core knowledge of trusts - suitable for providing clients with advice on trusts
- Anyone else seeking a more in-depth knowledge and understanding of trusts in the Czech Republic

What are the expected learning outcomes?

Participants who successfully complete this course will:

- Understand the structure of trusts in the Czech Republic
- Have a knowledge of the history of trusts
- Understand the provisions of the Czech Civil Code that relate to Trusts

- Understand key Common law concepts and their likely impact in the Czech Republic
- Be able to advise clients on the practical uses of trusts and on different trust structures
- Understand the tax treatment of Trusts and its impact on structuring
- Be familiar with the documentation associated with Trusts
- Have sufficient knowledge of the duties and responsibilities of Trustees to enable them to act in that role

What is the cost of the Course?
